NOTICE TO CASINO GAMING LICENSE APPLICANTS

The Commission, or a designated Committee of the Commission, shall examine all applications submitted for a casino gaming license under Amendment 100 and the Casino Gaming Rules. All applicants shall appear before the Commission for an interview and review of the information submitted in the application for a casino gaming license. The Commission shall select the most qualified applicant based upon the following factors:

- 1) Experience in the casino gaming industry;
- 2) Proof of the casino applicant's financial stability and ability to secure financing for the proposed casino and amenities;
- The details of the casino applicant's plans for the casino in Pope / Jefferson counties, including plans for a hotel and other amenities, and the details for the type of casino gaming and sports wagering proposed to be offered by the applicant.
- 4) Timeline for construction and opening of the casino and proposed amenities.
